

**Saturday, July 9**

**Sunday, July 10**

We will soak up the history of this ancient city by walking through the old town and the port. In the afternoon the boat will take us back to Talloires and we'll enjoy the riders for a group dinner.

**Monday, July 11**

Today you will get the chance to experience what it feels like to live as a duke on a castle. We will go and visit the 'Château de Menthon Saint-Bernard'. After that we'll catch some fresh air on the Roc de Chère from where you will enjoy some lovely views over the lake of Annecy.

We will make sure we'll get on time to the Col de Forclaz to cheer for our riders and see them get their first mountain climb victory.

**Tuesday, July 12**

Today we will see some serious action. We will leave early to Beaufort, which is famous for its cheese. But today it is also famous for the Tour de France passing through. After a stroll through the village we'll support our riders. After the caravan of the Tour de France has passed (kids bring an extra bag for the goodies they throw out of the cars!) we will see the best riders in the world race to the top.
